

The Maggie & Rose TIMELINE

2006

Maggie meets Rose...Maggie was running creative workshops and Rose was working on mini film classes. The Pair commence their Partnership and expand their themes, working out of the first Maggie & Rose a space in Albert Mews, Kensington.



2007

Due to member demand they moved to the much larger 58 Pembroke Road, Kensington in September... a Mews house complete with soft play, café, Cinema Snug and cooking & creative studios.

2008

The first books are Published – ‘A Lovely Story’ and ‘Oscar & Bentley Totally Save the Day’.



2009

Partnered with the Starlight children's charity for their event hosted at the Saachi Gallery to help terminally ill children by granting their wishes and providing hospital entertainment.

2010

Published 3 books with Walker Books: “This book is totally Rubbish”, “This book totally makes stuff grow” and “This book is totally christmassy”.



2012 / 2013

Successful raised £2 million to open the 2nd site in Chiswick. This 12,500 sq ft Club houses a double decker bus, roof terrace, brasserie soft play and also the first nursery for the brand with an emphasis on bringing education back to learning through play.



2014

The Kensington Club receives a makeover... A complete refurbishment is done to highlight the brand's interior design ethos.



2015

The Maggie & Rose @ Home range of bespoke, handcrafted furniture is born. The first international site, The Beach Club in Hong Kong, opened its doors in December. The Club becomes the showroom for the Maggie & Rose @ Home range.



2016

And beyond... The Maggie & Rose brand turns 10 and is on a rapid expansion, with the signing of a 17 book publishing deal, an animated TV series in the making and merchandise development. Oh and a few more Club and Nursery sites in negotiations!
