Our imaginative classes allow little ones and grown-ups to share in the fun of learning. Devised to take little ones on creative journeys, our classes reflect our belief that the process of imagination is key to a little one's development and learning. Our bespoke curriculum of multi-sensory, tactile (sometimes messy!) classes is led by in-house teachers trained to guide little ones to explore in their own way, at their own pace. Grown-ups can support their child in experimenting and decision-making, while also sharing in fun activities ranging from crafting to cooking – without any of the mess to clear up!

Each session will:

- introduce key concepts in numeracy and literacy
- provide opportunities to practice fine and gross motor skills
- help little ones to gain an understanding of the world around them
- build social skills and friendships
- encourage little ones to express their individuality
- foster the ability to make creative decisions
- push the limits of little imaginations
